The Deutscher Studenten Club and the Department of German Studies are inviting applications for the **Deutscher Studenten Club Study Abroad Scholarship** to help University of Arizona (UA) students fund their participation in study abroad programs in German-speaking countries.

The following scholarships are available:

- 1. Applicants need to have a minimum GPA of 3.0 in German classes.
- 2. Applicants must be full-time students of Junior, Senior or Graduate standing.
- 3. Applicants should complete the attached application form and submit a letter of application <u>in German</u>, stating qualifications, study objectives and career goals. If applying for summer study, provide the name of the program (e.g., Leipzig).
- 4. Applicants should supply the names and email addresses of two faculty members who are willing to endorse their application.
- 5. Applicants may submit supporting material that they consider relevant to their application.
- 6. If applying, applicants must commit to have an application for the proposed program of study on file in the Office of Study Abroad or the Department of German Studies.

Students of all majors and minors may apply, but preference will be given to students officially registered as German majors or minors. Interested students are asked to complete the attached application form and send it to:
