# Sampling • Representative sample Sample Population

· Size of sample determines accuracy

Number	Sampling Erro
200	+/- 7.2%
600	+/- 4.1%
800	+/- 3.6%
1000	+/- 3.2%
2000	+/- 2.2%

## Sample size = 1000 Sampling error = 3.2 percentage points Population True value Sample 3 Gallup Poll · "These results are based on telephone interviews with a randomly selected national sample of 1,003 adults, aged 18 years and older, conducted Jan. 6-8, 2006. For results based on this sample, one can say with 95% confidence that the maximum error attributable to sampling and other random effects is ±3 percentage points. In addition to sampling error, question wording and practical difficulties in conducting surveys can introduce error or bias into the findings of public opinion polls."

#### Range

- Samuel Alito: support 49%, oppose 30%, no opinion 21%
- Sample support Alito = 49% +/- 3%
- Sample oppose Alito = 30% +/- 3%

Misperceived Question  • Have you taken any bunny courses here at the University of Arizona?
