The prize is awarded annually for the best paper presented by a recent post-graduate scholar of no more than 5 years* at the Annual Meeting of the Western Regional Science Association.

Prize US \$300.-

(to be awarded in Springer books of the winner's choice)

The paper will be published in **The Annals of Regional Science**, official Journal of the WRSA, and announced on the Springer Website.



* Authors wishing to have their WRSA conference papers considered for the Springer Prize should certify at the time of submission of the paper to the conference organizer that they meet the five-year since doctorate requirement and that they wish to have their papers entered for consideration in the competition.
