 A statement of the purpose of the study (one sentence if possible). A statement of the methods and materials used. A summary of the results with sufficient detail to support the conclusions. A full statement of the conclusions reached. (It is not sufficient to state "The results will be discussed".) Do not use subtitles, e.g., methods, results, etc.
