1. Capitalize and make bold the entire title, making the title as brief as possible, e.g. 14 words or less.
2. List the authors (with last name and initials of presenting author underlined), the name of the institution and its location.
3. After one space, organize the body of the abstract in the following manner:
 - A statement of the purpose of the study (one sentence if possible).
 - A statement of the methods and materials used.
 - A summary of the results with sufficient detail to support the conclusions.
 - A full statement of the conclusions reached. (It is not sufficient to state "The results will be discussed".)
 - Do not use subtitles, e.g., methods, results, etc.
